## What we do?

**WE PROVIDE** a Personal assistant service to people with physical and sensory disabilities (18-65) known as Leaders throughout Co. Leitrim and West Cavan.

### ■ LEADER

Is a person with a disability who employs the support of a personal assistant to allow them to live independently in their own home, take up employment or partake in community and social activities.

### ■ PERSONAL ASSISTANT

Is a paid employee working with a leader to assist them with duties to live independently.

**TRAINING** is provided for leaders and personal assistants in personal development, communications etc.

**SPORTS AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES** are organised to meet the needs of our members. Any suggestions or comments regarding activities are most welcome.
